I would like to invite you to a briefing by Mr. Rafael de la Rubia, Director of World Without Wars/ Mundo Sin Guerras and International Spokesperson for the World March for Peace and Nonviolence, an unprecedented international social mobilization that will take place on 6 continents between October 2, 2009 (International Day of Nonviolence) and January 2, 2010.

The World March for Peace and Nonviolence is a three-month worldwide march involving more than one million people worldwide. Its objective is to generate a global consciousness that universally condemns all forms violence and to raise awareness of the urgent need for nuclear disarmament and the end to aggressions between countries. A core group of marchers will cross the planet from New Zealand to Argentina while simultaneously, in more than 100 countries, marches, festivals, exhibits, concerts, forums, conferences and social, cultural, educational and athletic events will take place calling for an end to wars, nuclear arms and all forms of violence.
